Wescott Boulevard Improvements Overview

Dorchester County proposes roadway widening and improvements along Wescott Boulevard from Ballantine Drive to Patriot Boulevard to reduce traffic congestion, improve safety, and enhance bicycle and pedestrian accommodations. The proposed project will include curb and gutter, enclosed drainage, shared use path, sidewalk, and associated improvements.



REDUCE TRAFFIC CONGESTION

The Wescott Boulevard corridor currently experiences good to fair traffic conditions with some delays. However, future traffic projections indicate poor conditions with significant to extreme delays at intersections.



IMPROVE SAFETY

The Wescott Boulevard corridor has a higher crash rate than the State crash rate average, with a total of 41 crashes over a 5-year period.




ACCOMODATE BICYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS

The project will include a shared use path and sidewalk for accommodating bicyclists and pedestrians.

Proposed Improvements

- Two 12' travel lanes westbound
- Two 12' travel lanes eastbound
- Landscaped median
- Dedicated turn lanes at intersections throughout the corridor
- 12' shared use path on eastbound side
- 5' sidewalk on westbound side
- Curb and gutter
- Roundabout at Wescott Blvd and Ballantine Drive



EXISTING & FUTURE TRAFFIC

The Project Team completed a traffic study that analyzed the existing and future conditions for Wescott Boulevard. Traffic performance is measured by Level of Service and Delay. As shown in the figure below, Wescott Boulevard operates relatively well today; however, without improvements, conditions will worsen significantly in the future.

Level of Service (LOS)


is a rating system that uses letter grades to describe traffic operations. LOS ranges from A (free flow) to F (stop-and-go).

Delay (seconds per vehicle)

measures how long, on average, a vehicle is delayed at an intersection. More delay means longer wait times and slower travel; less delay means traffic moves more efficiently.
