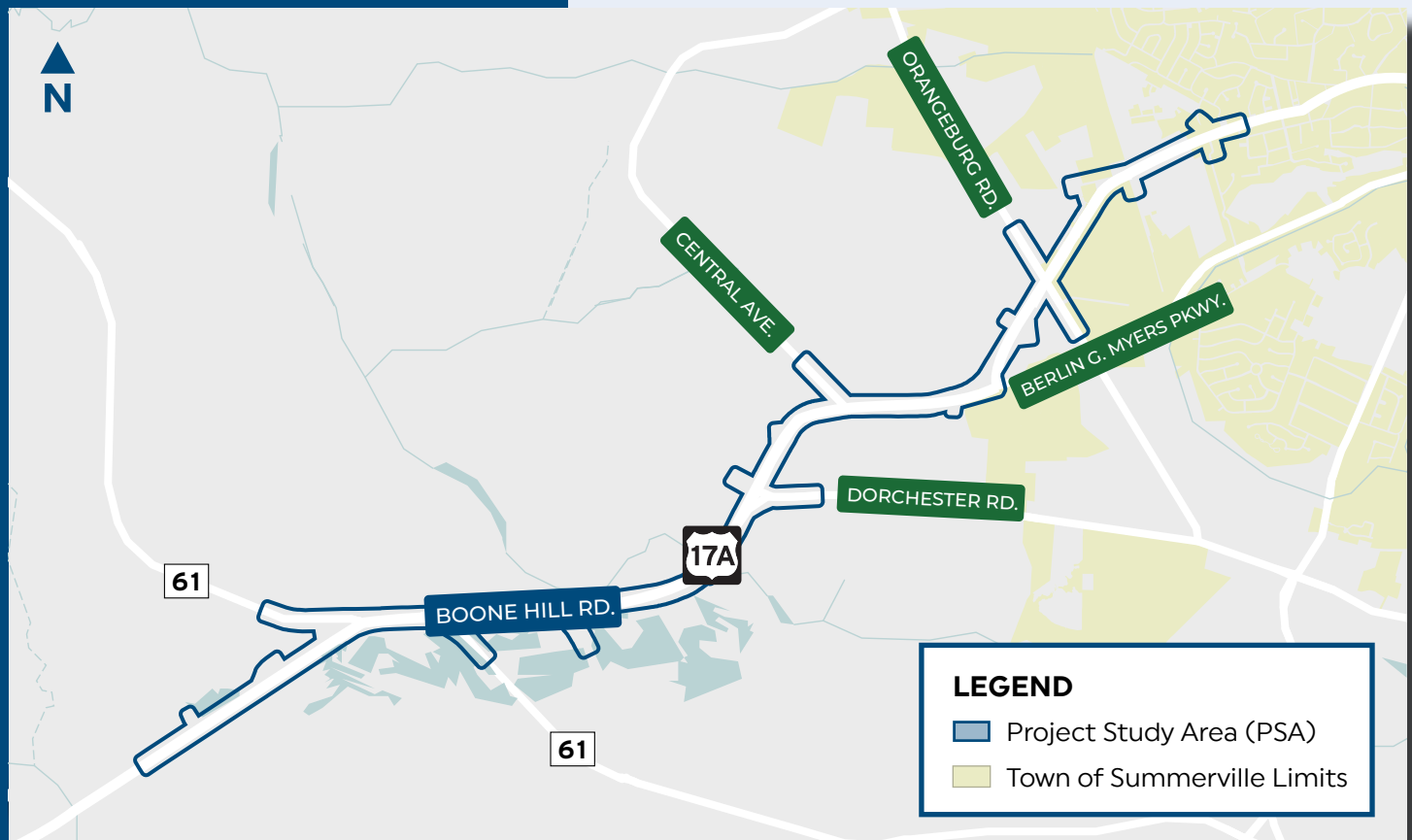
Meeting Purpose

US 17A (Boone Hill Road) Improvements Overview

The US Highway 17A (Boone Hill Road) Improvements Project proposes to widen and improve associated intersections on US 17A for approximately 6.6 miles between Research Center Drive and Luden Drive to reduce traffic congestion, improve safety, and accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians.

Rising traffic and future growth mean several segments will face capacity issues without improvements.



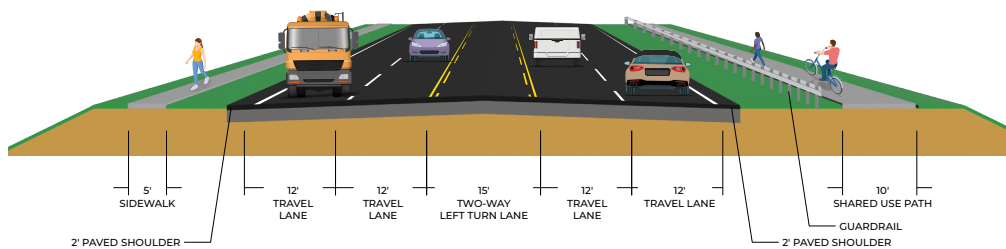
IMPROVE SAFETY

This project will improve safety and mobility along this busy corridor.



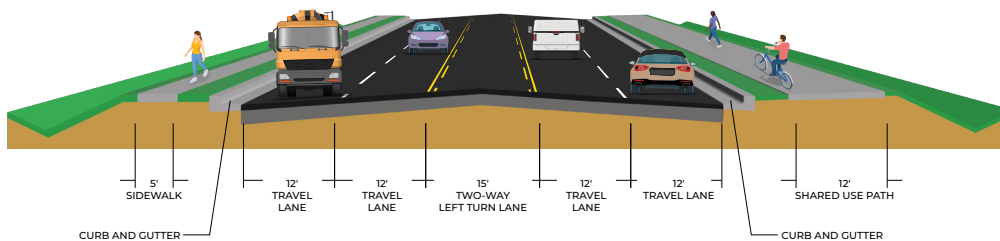
ACCOMMODATE BICYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS

This project will provide better pedestrian and bike facilities.



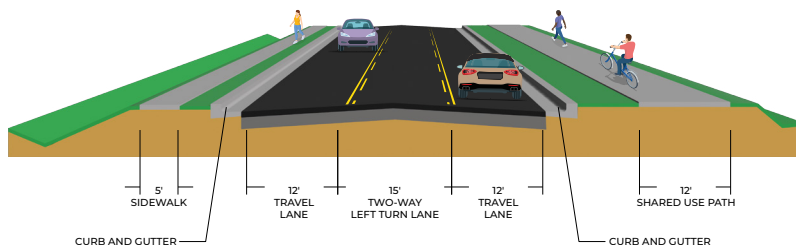
Research Center Drive to Dorchester Road

- Two 12' Travel Lanes in Each Direction
- 15' Two-way Left Turn Lane
- 10' Shared Use Path on South Side
- 5' Sidewalk on North Side
- 2' Paved Shoulder



Dorchester Road to Berlin G. Myers Parkway

- Two 12' Travel Lanes in Each Direction
- 15' Two-way Left Turn Lane
- 12' Shared Use Path on South Side
- 5' Sidewalk on North Side
- Curb and Gutter



Berlin G. Myers Parkway to Luden Drive

- One 12' Travel Lane in Each Direction
- 15' Two-way Left Turn Lane
- 12' Shared Use Path on South Side
- 5' Sidewalk on North Side
- Curb and Gutter

Title VI Compliance: Dorchester County complies with all nondiscrimination requirements set forth by the Federal regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. 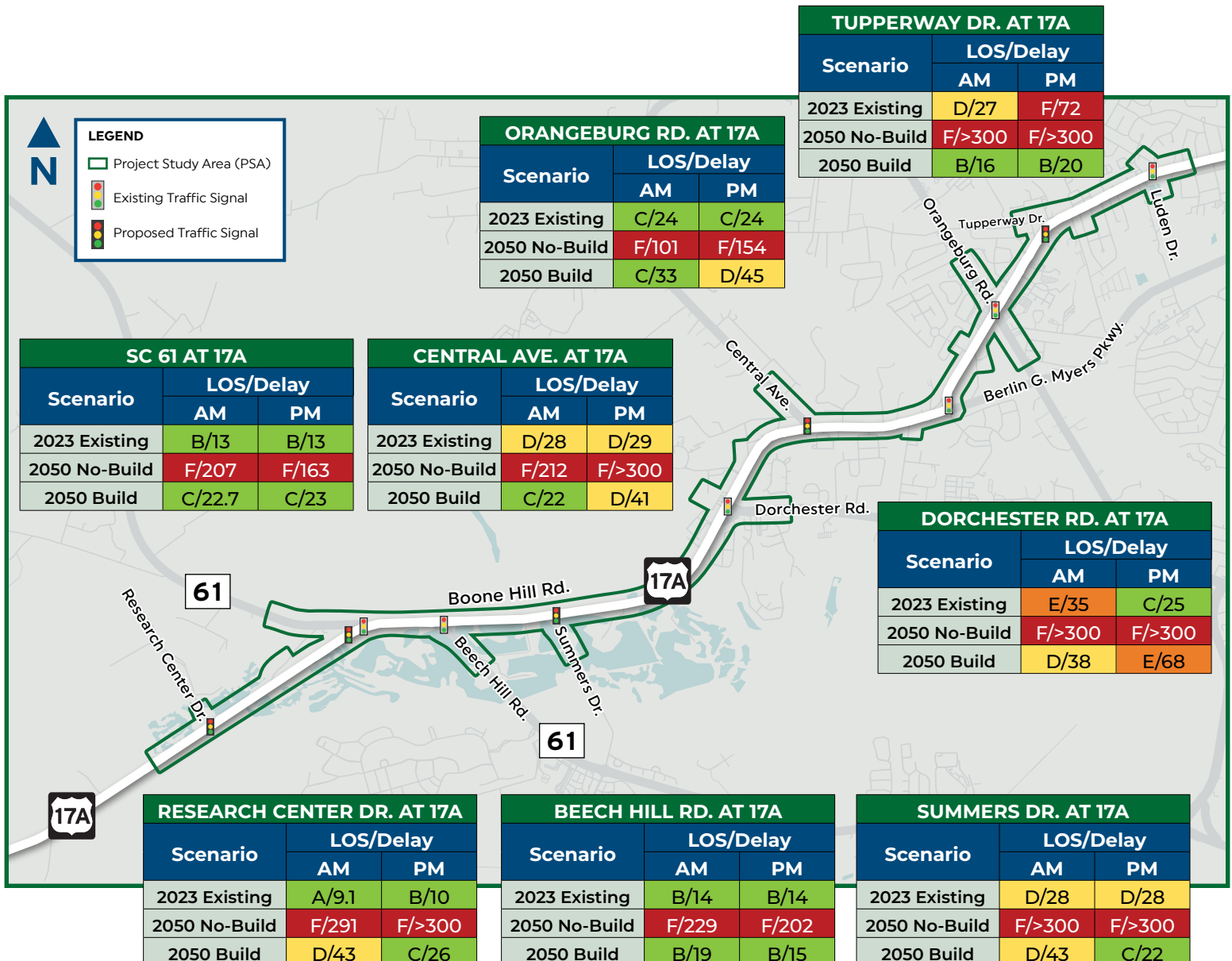
EXISTING AND FUTURE TRAFFIC

The Project Team completed a traffic study that analyzed the existing and future conditions for US Highway 17A between Research Center Drive and Luden/Hutson Drive. Traffic performance is measured by Level of Service and Delay. As shown in the figure below, without improvements, traffic conditions will worsen drastically over time.

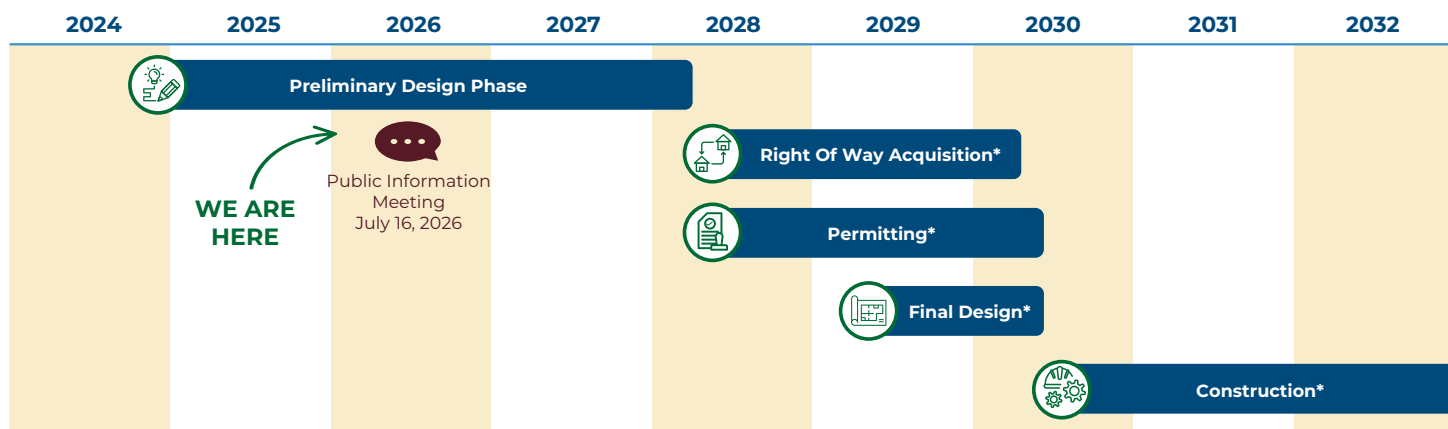
Level of Service (LOS) is a rating system that uses letter grades to describe traffic operations. LOS ranges from A (free flow) to F (stop-and-go).

Delay (seconds per vehicle) measures how long, on average, a vehicle is delayed at an intersection. More delay means longer wait times and slower travel; less delay means traffic moves more efficiently.

Funding

The US 17A (Boone Hill Road) Improvements Project is being funded through the **Dorchester County Transportation Sales Tax Program**. The project is currently only funded through Preliminary Design Phase. The project is being developed to be eligible for federal grants and funding to supplement the project cost and bridge the funding gap for project completion. The current project estimate is \$213M.
