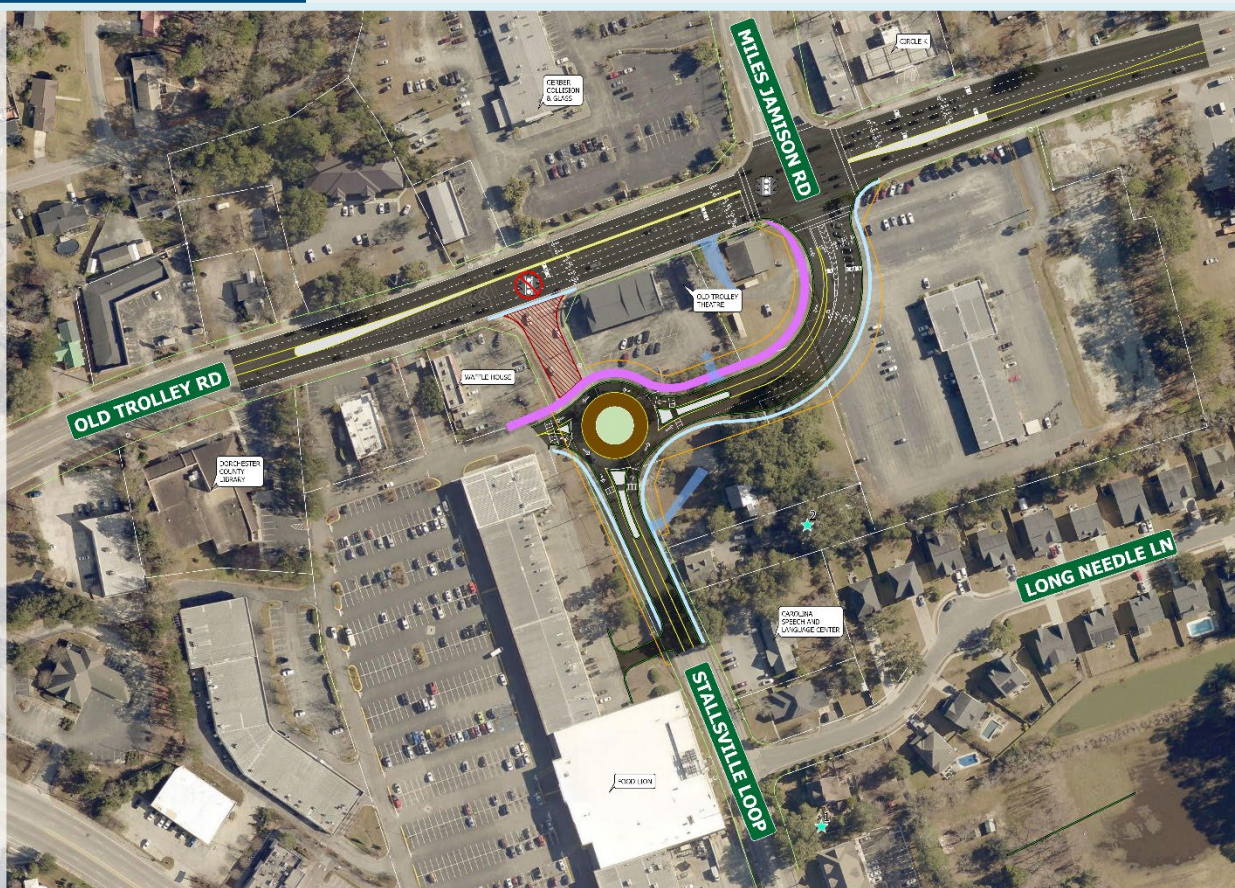

Project Overview

The Stallville Loop Project includes the realignment of Stallville Loop from its existing intersection with Old Trolley Road, to align with the intersection of Old Trolley Road and Miles Jamison Road. Two twelve-foot travel lanes; a single lane roundabout; a 15-foot, two-way center left turn lane; five-foot sidewalks (or 12-foot shared use path); and new striping on Old Trolley Road are included in the proposed project. The project will reduce congestion and improve traffic flow.

Budget and Funding

The Stallville Loop Project is made possible by the Dorchester County Transportation Sales Tax Program.

Total Project Budget: \$8,611,586

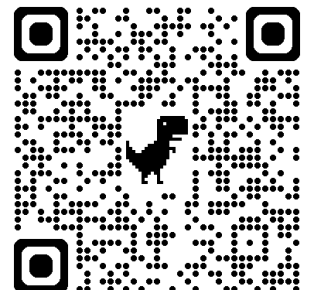
