

The US Highway 17A (Boone Hill Road) Improvements Project proposes to widen and improve associated intersections on US 17A for approximately 6.6 miles between Research Center Drive and Luden Drive to reduce traffic congestion, improve safety, and accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians.

The purpose of this project is to reduce traffic congestion, improve safety and accommodate pedestrians and bicyclists along the corridor.

This project will improve safety and mobility along this busy corridor.

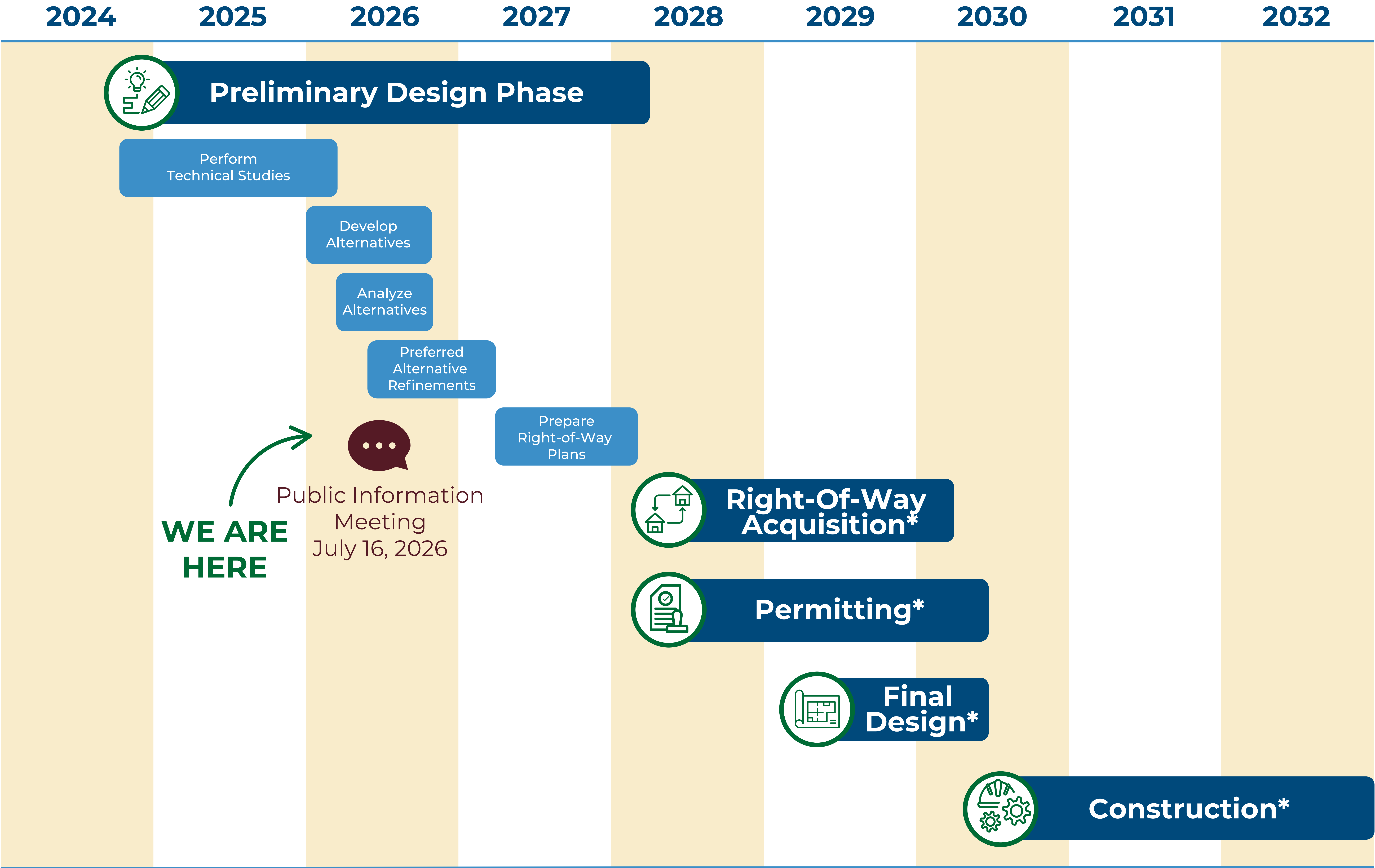


ACCOMMODATE BICYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS
