Project Overview

Dorchester County proposes to replace the Pointer Drive bridge over an unnamed tributary to Dorchester Creek in Dorchester County, South Carolina. The bridge replacement is in the Quail Arbor neighborhood.

The proposed work consists of replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge. The existing bridge would be demolished and removed prior to the construction of the proposed structure. The proposed work would also include improvements along Pointer Drive within the vicinity of the new structure. Pointer Drive will be closed during construction and a detour will be in place.
